

My grandfather, Percy Mordaunt Barnard (1868-1941), produced more than two hundred catalogues and stock lists for his antiquarian bookselling business between 1905 and 1934. Most of them contain meticulous and detailed descriptions of the books he offered for sale (as well as prices), and modern antiquarian booksellers and bibliographers can find them to be useful reference tools. I have examined the holdings of a number of libraries, and my own private collection, and have compiled the attached table of his catalogues, with the relevant library shelfmarks and other information.

### Catalogue Series

The catalogues can be divided into five separate series:

- The main numbered series of 182 catalogues (designated "Cat nnn").
- A separate series of 12 catalogues issued from his branch in Manchester in 1909 and 1910 (designated "Man nn")
- Four "lists" of books, designated "A" to "D" issued in 1914 and 1915 (designated "List x")
- Four supplementary, un-numbered, lists of books, issued in 1910 and in 1915 (designated "Supp x")
- Five handwritten "hand lists" of books, issued in 1923 to selected customers (designated "Hand n")

Almost all the catalogues are un-dated, though the accession date-stamps on the copies at the Bodleian Library can be used to establish dates for those in their collection, with the remainder readily fitted in chronologically.

Most of the catalogues cover books, manuscripts, tracts etc., but a few also include prints, drawings and other artwork. This side of the business was eventually taken over by my grandmother Alice Mary Barnard (née Taunton, 1872-1951) who, initially in partnership with A.G.W. Murray (1884-1919, a former assistant to my grandfather, and librarian of Trinity College Cambridge), and later with my uncle Osbert Barnard (1903-1985), began issuing separate catalogues from around 1915 under the name **Craddock and Barnard**.

### Places of Business

The earliest catalogues in the main series were issued from **4 Mount Pleasant Road, Saffron Walden, Essex**, but catalogues 12 (April 1907) to 124 were issued from **12 Dudley Road, Tunbridge Wells, Kent**. Catalogues 125 (1921) onwards were issued from "larger and more convenient premises" at **17 Church Road, Tunbridge Wells**.

Catalogue 27 in the main series (1909) is the first to mention a branch at **85 Bridge Street, Manchester**, from which the 12 catalogues in the Manchester series were issued; catalogue 39 of the main series (1910) is the last to mention this branch, so it was evidently fairly short-lived – all the Manchester catalogues at the Bodleian are date-stamped between January 1909 and October 1910.

## Library Holdings

The most comprehensive collection is at the **Bodleian Library** in Oxford, which holds all but 19 of the main series, all but two of the Manchester series, and all of the “lists” apart from one of the Hand lists. Six of the missing catalogues can be found in other collections. The Bodleian’s online catalogue descriptions are somewhat incomplete and misleading, and I hope that the attached table will clarify their holdings, which are all loose and held in a set of cardboard boxes and an envelope.

The **British Library** in London holds 66 catalogues from the main series, nine from the Manchester series, and two of the “lists”. The originals appear to be bound into a number of volumes, which are on restricted access, but good microfilm copies are available at the St Pancras reading room (and the shelfmarks given in the attached table refer to these). Again, the online catalogue descriptions are somewhat incomplete and misleading.

The **Grolier Club** in New York (<https://www.grolierclub.org/>) has 26 catalogues, all from the main series, which are shown individually in its online catalogue.

My own **private collection** comprises just over one hundred of his catalogues. There are five bound volumes (generally of related subject-matter) of my grandfather’s own copies, in some cases with pencil annotations of the buyer of each item. There are also some thirty loose copies (with only a few duplicates of those in the bound volumes) which I purchased in 2022 from the bookseller Robin Halwas.

There are also a small number of catalogues at **Cambridge University Library**, but I have not yet fully investigated their holdings.

## Untraced Catalogues and Lists

There are 17 catalogues and lists whose existence can be inferred from gaps in the numbered sequences, but for which I have so far been unable to trace copies. These are numbers 1-8, 10, 14, 17, 23, 90, and 135 in the main series; numbers 5 and 6 in the Manchester series; and Hand List number 3. In some of these cases the main subjects covered are indicated in lists of “recently-issued catalogues” printed in subsequent issues.

A note in Cat 136 indicates that Cat 135 was never issued, as its entire contents had been sold *en bloc*, but the Bodleian holds a Galley Proof which appears to represent at least part of its contents.

I would be most interested to hear of any other substantial collections of P.M. Barnard’s catalogues, and most particularly of course, of copies of any of the issues I have been unable to trace.
