

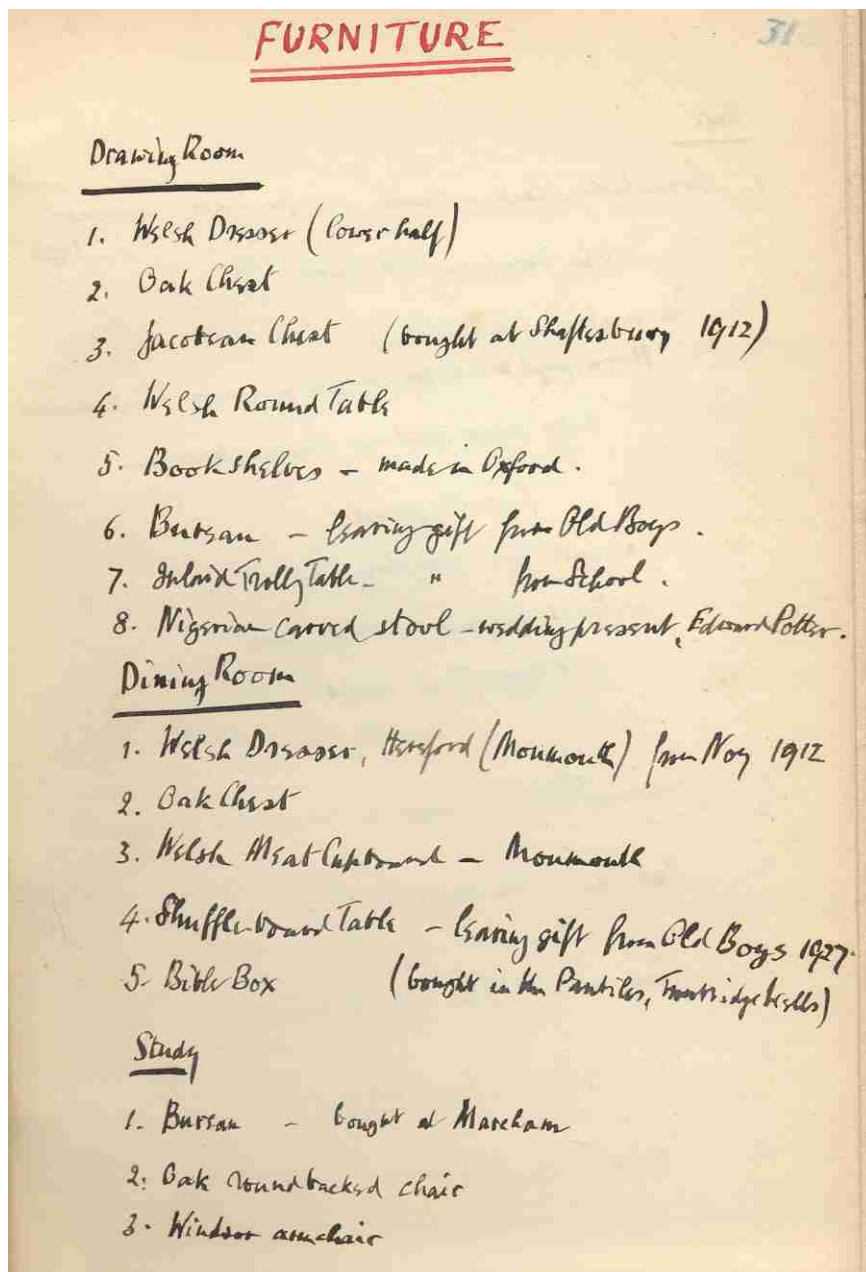
Lares and Penates
